

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METHODOLOGY

A Web survey was conducted from November 22nd to November 25th, 2019 among 1,527 English and Frenchspeaking Canadians, 18 years of age or older.

Using data from Statistics Canada, results were weighted according to gender, age, region, mother tongue, education and presence of minor children in the household in order to ensure a representative sample of the entire population under review.

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of 1,527 respondents would have a margin of error of \pm 2.5%, 19 times out of 20.


- The numbers presented in this report have been rounded out and their sum (based on the actual numbers before rounding) might not correspond to the manual addition of rounded numbers.

Q1. In general, are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the health care system?



Q2. In your opinion, have the additional amounts injected into the health care system over the past ten years by the government of your province produced good results?





Q3. Would you agree or disagree that the government should allow patients increased access to care provided by private health entrepreneurs, as long as medically required care remains covered by the government?



Q4. Would you agree or disagree that the government should allow private companies to manage public hospitals, provided that medically required care remains covered by the government?



Q5. Do you believe that your health care system currently treats patients in a timely manner?



Q6. Do you believe that individuals should have the right to take charge of their health and buy private health insurance if they are not treated within a reasonable time in the public health care system?







Q8. Would you be willing to pay for virtual consultations with your doctor to avoid having to travel or wait?









